A local Law No. 1 of 2017, Town of Cuyler, entitled "Board of Assessment Review" is hereby adopted to Read in its entirety as follows:

A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR THE TOWN'S BOARD OF ASSESSMENT REVIEW

Local Law # 1 of 2017.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Cuyler, in the County of Cortland, as follows:

WHEREAS, New York Real Property Tax Law section 523 provides that the town shall have a Board of Assessment that shall consist of a minimum of three (3) members and a maximum of five (5) members, and WHEREAS, the Town currently has five (5) members who constitute the Town's Board of Assessment Review and WHEREAS, the Town desires to reduce the number of members constituting the Town's Board of Assessment Review from five (5) members to three (3) members. NOW, THEREFORE, the Town hereby resolves as follows:

The Board of Assessment Review shall consist of three (3) members.

This Local Law supercedes any prior Local Laws of the Town of Cuyler inconsistent with the provisions contained herein.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing as required by law.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. _____ of 20____ of the City of _____ having been submitted to referendum pursuant to the provisions of section (36)(37) of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of such city voting thereon at the (special)(general) election held on _____ 20____, became operative.

6. (County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. _____ of 20____ of the County of _____ State of New York having been submitted to the electors at the General Election of November _____ 20____, pursuant to subdivisions 5 and 7 of section 33 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the cities of said county as a unit and a majority of the qualified electors of the towns of said county considered as a unit voting at said general election, became operative.
