A Local Law of the Town of Cuyler Establishing a Curfew for Minors.

Be it enacted by theTOWN BOARD..... of the
Town of CUYLER..... as follows:

**Local Law No. 1 For the Year 2006
For the Town of Cuyler Establishing
A Curfew for Minors**

BE IT ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Pursuant to the authority vested in this Board by Article 2 Section 10.1(ii)a(12) of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, this Board does hereby establish a curfew as follows:

HOURS PRESCRIBED:

No child under the age of eighteen (18) years shall be in or upon any of the streets, all town property, parks or public places in the Town of Cuyler in the nighttime, after the hour of 9:00 PM unless such child is accompanied by his or her parent, guardian or other person having legal care or control of such child.

Section 2. RESPONSIBILITY OF ADULT FOR VIOLATION BY WARD

Any parents, guardian or other adult person having the legal care and custody of any child under the age of eighteen (18) years shall not allow or permit such child or ward under such age to go to be in or upon any of the streets, all town property, parks, or public places in the town after the hours specified on those days prescribed herein.

Section 3. EXEMPTIONS.

- (A) Minors who are accompanied by a parent or guardian.**
- (B) Travel directly to or from any adult sponsored activities sponsored by an school, church, civic or non-profit organization.**
- (C) Employment which necessitates the minor to be out after curfew.**

Section 4. PENALTIES FOR OFFENSE.

- (A) Any minor who violates the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a violation and punished by a fine of up to \$250.00 or imprisonment for a period of not to exceed fifteen (15) days or both.**

Section 5. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing as prescribed by Law.
