## REGULAR MEETING OF THE CUYLER TOWN BOARD

## June 8, 2023

Present were: Supervisor Randall, Clerk Custer, Councilwomen Stafford and Corbin and Councilman Smith and Superintendent Breed. Absent: Councilman White

Supervisor Randall led the Pledge of Allegiance and the regular board meeting was called to order at 7:00pm.

On a motion from Councilwoman Corbin and seconded by Councilman Smith the board approved the minutes from May 11, 2023 meeting. All Ayes

Superintendent Breed stated that they have been cleaning ditches on Cowles Settlement road and Dog Hollow road. John asked Councilman Smith his about Hydro seeding. Councilman Smith stated that Soil and Water will do it because they got a state grant. John also stated that the culvert has been fixed on Pease Hill road.

Code Enforcer report read by board members present.

Councilwoman Corbin asked about the dogs at the brown house by Depot. She has not seen anyone there in days. Supervisor Randall will contact our dog control officer and have her check it out. Councilwoman Corbin called the health department on the trash piled up in front of house and they told her it was a code enforcer issue. She contacted Chuck Ladd.

No Justice report.

We did not receive any roof repair bids so we will keep it open for another month per board.

Supervisor Randall and the board reviewed the highway policy and made some changes.

Supervisor Randall stated that our town attorney had gone over the local law for Solar and to opt out of the 487 plan but needs more clarification and changed some of the wording.

A public hearing will be held on July 13, 2023 to approve the local laws.
