

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CUYLER TOWN BOARD

March 11, 2021

Present were: Supervisor Randall, Clerk Custer, Councilmen White and Smith and Councilwomen Stafford and Corbin, Superintendent Breed.

Also present were: Lee Smith, Alan Fink, and Code Enforcer Neil Williams.

Supervisor Randall led the pledge of Allegiance and the regular town board meeting was called to order at 7:00pm.

On a motion from Councilman Smith and seconded by Councilwoman Corbin the board approved the minutes from February 11, 2021 board meeting.

On a motion from Councilman White and seconded by Councilwoman Stafford the board authorized payment of bills on abstract # 3.

Superintendent Breed stated that the 550 was still down and I was at Dovi motors in Cortland. The turbo went in it and when the truck came back there was a knocking noise and it blew the motor. Supervisor Randall has been in contact with Luke Dovi with this issue. John also stated that they replaced a used pipe at Betty Vandee's. John also stated that he has not gotten any estimates on replacing the highway garage's furnace yet, but will.

Code Enforcer Neil Williams stated that he has given the property owners of the two trailers on East Keeney road a least a year to have them removed and they have not done so. He stated he will contact them again but if not gone by May they should go back on tax roll. The code report was read by all board members.

No justice report but Alan Fink did state he has to recertification coming up.

Dog report read by all board members.

Supervisor Randall asked for a motion to extend collect taxes so on a motion from Councilwoman Stafford and seconded by Councilman Smith to have an extension to collect taxes until May 31, 2021.

Supervisor Randall stated she was told the town of Cuyler will receive about a \$ 105 thousand for the COVID relief package from the state and it can only be used for water and sewer or broadband. She stated we should get fifty percent in sixty days and the other in twelve months. She also stated that the sewer lot needs to be upgraded and would have to have an engineer to design the new sewer system. She stated this could all change.

Councilman Smith stated that the county has not reviewed the hazard mitigation plan yet. He also talked about a gentlemen that is having a problem with a pile of compost and wanted to know if the town could help out in any way but still needs to talk to the guy and arrange something.

On a motion from Councilwoman Corbin and seconded by Councilwoman Stafford the regular meeting of the Cuyler town board was adjourned at 7:38pm.
