

REGULAR MEETIG OF THE CUYLER TOWN BOARD

August 12, 2021

Present were: Supervisor Randall, Clerk Custer, Councilman White and Councilwoman Stafford, and Superintendent Breed.

Absent were: Councilwoman Corbin and Councilman Smith.

Also present were: Deputy Supervisor Lee Smith, Code Enforcer Neil Williams, and Adam Aldrich.

Supervisor Randall led the Pledge of Allegiance and the regular board meeting was called to order at 7:00pm.

On a motion from Councilman White and seconded by Councilwoman Stafford the board approved the minutes from July 8, 2021 board meeting.

He stated that the real estate lady is having a difficult time with what need needs done for the fire inspection. He also suggested that the town set a rate for doing inspections for banks. Supervisor Randall suggested getting another towns fee schedule and look at that.

Councilman White stated he has not heard back from anyone on the fence for the cemetery.

The town will hold a public hearing on September 9, 2021 on local law to opt out of the cannabis retail sales/ dispensaries. The clerk will advertise.

Supervisor Randall stated that the sewer is having issues with the plastic distribution boxes and valves. Councilman White also suggested that the sewer fees be raised a little each year.

On a motion from Councilman White and seconded by Councilwoman Stafford to have Dewey Northup repair the sewer issues and can spend up to \$15,000.00.

Adam Aldrich came to the board meeting to ask the town subdivide 1.74 acres from the 20 acres that is on the property on West Keeney Road and the road frontage is not enough for what Cuyler's laws states. Code Enforcer Neil Williams will contact the county.
